### Statement of Requirements

A joint major in Anthropology and Religion may be earned by completion of 14 courses (56 hours). 20 of the hours are to be distributed as follows: Anthropology 201 **or** 210; Anthropology 202; Religion 300; Religion 490; and one religion course from Religion 301-320. The additional 9 courses (36 hours) are comprised of four courses in Religion (two at the 300 level or above) and 5 courses in Anthropology (not including 101). A minimum of a C average in the major is required.
